Cost/Rent

Cost of living in the Student Residence Hall is \$500 per student per month.*

Required Residence Living

First year (Fall Semester) undergraduate pre-licensure full-time and part-time students who live outside a 50-mile radius and full-time and part-time sohomores living in residence as of April 30 of the previous academic year are required to live on campus.

Deposit

A deposit of \$200 is required and will be refunded once resident has completely moved out of the apartments and a housing walk through and condition report has been completed.

Housing Agreement

Ten or 12 month agreements are available.

Utility Costs

Heat, water and electric utilities are included in the rent.

Phone/Cable/Internet

Cable and internet is included. Internet ready. A phone jack is in each apartment.

Rules/Regulations

Each student will receive a comprehensive Residence Hall Handbook outlining policies and procedures and will be required to sign a statement indicating they have read and understand the contents of the book.

Selecting Roommates

You may request your own or have the College select based on availability.

Parking

Residents may park in the garage adjacent to the Residence Halls.

Dining

Available at Mount Carmel East, West, and St. Ann's campus cafeterias

Safety and Security

Each unit comes equipped with a security system. Students may request an escort from hospital Safety and Security after hours. Blue phones are located at several locations on campus including outside of the Residence Halls.

Resident Advisors

There will be three resident advisors (RAs) per Residence Hall.

Campus Activities and Events

Many activities and events are scheduled throughout the year for Mount Carmel students. Students are encouraged to become involved in a variety of activities, as it is an important part of the College experience.
